8/30/09	<b>Colossians 3:16 (ESV)</b> <sup>16</sup> Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God.
9/6/09	<b>Deuteronomy 6:4-5 (ESV)</b> <sup>4</sup> “Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. <sup>5</sup> You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might.
9/13/09	<b>Deuteronomy 6:6-7 (ESV)</b> <sup>6</sup> And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart. <sup>7</sup> You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise.
9/20/09	<b>Exodus 20:1-2 (ESV)</b> <sup>1</sup> And God spoke all these words, saying, <sup>2</sup> “I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery.
9/27/09	<b>Exodus 20:3 (ESV)</b> <sup>3</sup> “You shall have no other gods before me.
10/4/09	<b>Exodus 20:4 (ESV)</b> <sup>4</sup> “You shall not make for yourself a carved image, or any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth.
10/11/09	<b>Exodus 20:5-6 (ESV)</b> <sup>5</sup> You shall not bow down to them or serve them, for I the Lord your God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children to the third and the fourth generation of those who hate me, <sup>6</sup> but showing steadfast love to thousands of those who love me and keep my commandments.
10/18/09	<b>Exodus 20:7 (ESV)</b> <sup>7</sup> “You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain, for the Lord will not hold him guiltless who takes his name in vain.
10/25/09	<b>Exodus 20:8 (ESV)</b> <sup>8</sup> “Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.
11/1/09	<b>Exodus 20:9-10a (ESV)</b> <sup>9</sup> Six days you shall labor, and do all your work, <sup>10a</sup> but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the Lord your God.
11/8/09	<b>Exodus 20:10b (ESV)</b> <sup>10b</sup> On it you shall not do any work, you, or your son, or your daughter, your male servant, or your female servant, or your livestock, or the sojourner who is within your gates.

11/15/09	<b>Exodus 20:11 (ESV)</b> <sup>11</sup> For in six days the Lord made heaven and earth, the sea, and all that is in them, and rested on the seventh day. Therefore the Lord blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy.
11/22/09	<b>Exodus 20:12 (ESV)</b> <sup>12</sup> “Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be long in the land that the Lord your God is giving you.
11/29/09	<b>Exodus 20:13 (ESV)</b> <sup>13</sup> “You shall not murder.
12/6/09	<b>Exodus 20:14 (ESV)</b> <sup>14</sup> “You shall not commit adultery.
12/13/09	<b>Exodus 20:15 (ESV)</b> <sup>15</sup> “You shall not steal.
12/20/09	<b>Exodus 20:16 (ESV)</b> <sup>16</sup> “You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.
12/27/09	<b>Exodus 20:17 (ESV)</b> <sup>17</sup> “You shall not covet your neighbor’s house; you shall not covet your neighbor’s wife, or his male servant, or his female servant, or his ox, or his donkey, or anything that is your neighbor’s.”
1/3/10	<b>Colossians 3:1-2 (ESV)</b> <sup>1</sup> If then you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. <sup>2</sup> Set your minds on things that are above, not on things that are on earth.
1/10/10	<b>Colossians 3:3 (ESV)</b> <sup>3</sup> For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God.
1/17/10	<b>Colossians 3:4 (ESV)</b> <sup>4</sup> When Christ who is your life appears, then you also will appear with him in glory.
1/24/10	<b>Colossians 3:5-7 (ESV)</b> <sup>5</sup> Put to death therefore what is earthly in you: sexual immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry. <sup>6</sup> On account of these the wrath of God is coming. <sup>7</sup> In these you too once walked, when you were living in them.
1/31/10	<b>Colossians 3:8 (ESV)</b> <sup>8</sup> But now you must put them all away: anger, wrath, malice, slander, and obscene talk from your mouth.

2/7/10	<b>Colossians 3:9-10 (ESV)</b> <sup>9</sup> Do not lie to one another, seeing that you have put off the old self with its practices <sup>10</sup> and have put on the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge after the image of its creator.
2/14/10	<b>Colossians 3:11 (ESV)</b> <sup>11</sup> Here there is not Greek and Jew, circumcised and uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave, free; but Christ is all, and in all.
2/21/10	<b>Colossians 3:12 (ESV)</b> <sup>12</sup> Put on then, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, compassionate hearts, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience,
2/28/10	<b>Colossians 3:13 (ESV)</b> <sup>13</sup> bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive.
3/7/10	<b>Colossians 3:14 (ESV)</b> <sup>14</sup> And above all these put on love, which binds everything together in perfect harmony.
3/14/10	<b>Colossians 3:15 (ESV)</b> <sup>15</sup> And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body. And be thankful.
3/21/10	<b>Colossians 3:16 (ESV)</b> <sup>16</sup> Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God.
3/28/10	<b>Colossians 3:17 (ESV)</b> <sup>17</sup> And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.
4/4/10	<b>Colossians 3:18 (ESV)</b> <sup>18</sup> Wives, submit to your husbands, as is fitting in the Lord.
4/11/10	<b>Colossians 3:19 (ESV)</b> <sup>19</sup> Husbands, love your wives, and do not be harsh with them.
4/18/10	<b>Colossians 3:20 (ESV)</b> <sup>20</sup> Children, obey your parents in everything, for this pleases the Lord.
4/25/10	<b>Colossians 3:21 (ESV)</b> <sup>21</sup> Fathers, do not provoke your children, lest they become discouraged.
5/2/10	<b>Colossians 3:22 (ESV)</b> <sup>22</sup> Slaves, obey in everything those who are your earthly masters, not by way of eye-service, as people-pleasers, but with sincerity of heart, fearing the Lord.

5/9/10	<b>Colossians 3:23 (ESV)</b> <sup>23</sup> Whatever you do, work heartily, as for the Lord and not for men,
5/16/10	<b>Colossians 3:24 (ESV)</b> <sup>24</sup> knowing that from the Lord you will receive the inheritance as your reward. You are serving the Lord Christ.
5/23/10	<b>Colossians 3:25 (ESV)</b> <sup>25</sup> For the wrongdoer will be paid back for the wrong he has done, and there is no partiality.
5/30/10	<b>John 1:1-2 (ESV)</b> <sup>1</sup> In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. <sup>2</sup> He was in the beginning with God.
6/6/10	<b>John 1:3 (ESV)</b> <sup>3</sup> All things were made through him, and without him was not any thing made that was made.
6/13/10	<b>John 1:4-5 (ESV)</b> <sup>4</sup> In him was life, and the life was the light of men. <sup>5</sup> The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.
6/20/10	<b>John 1:6-7 (ESV)</b> <sup>6</sup> There was a man sent from God, whose name was John. <sup>7</sup> He came as a witness, to bear witness about the light, that all might believe through him.
6/27/10	<b>John 1:8-9 (ESV)</b> <sup>8</sup> He was not the light, but came to bear witness about the light. <sup>9</sup> The true light, which enlightens everyone, was coming into the world.
7/4/10	<b>John 1:10-11 (ESV)</b> <sup>10</sup> He was in the world, and the world was made through him, yet the world did not know him. <sup>11</sup> He came to his own, and his own people did not receive him.
7/11/10	<b>John 1:12-13 (ESV)</b> <sup>12</sup> But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God, <sup>13</sup> who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God.
7/18/10	<b>John 1:14 (ESV)</b> <sup>14</sup> And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.
7/25/10	<b>John 1:15 (ESV)</b> <sup>15</sup> (John bore witness about him, and cried out, “This was he of whom I said, ‘He who comes after me ranks before me, because he was before me.’”)

8/1/10	<b>John 1:16 (ESV)</b> <sup>16</sup> And from his fullness we have all received, grace upon grace.
8/8/10	<b>John 1:17 (ESV)</b> <sup>17</sup> For the law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.
8/15/10	<b>John 1:18 (ESV)</b> <sup>18</sup> No one has ever seen God; the only God, who is at the Father's side, he has made him known.
