1/12/14	Psalm 33:8	⁸ Let all the earth fear the LORD; let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of him!
1/19/14	Exodus 20:2-3	² "I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery. ³ "You shall have no other gods before me.
1/26/14	Exodus 17:7	⁷ And he called the name of the place Massah (testing) and Meribah (quarreling), because of the quarreling of the people of Israel, and because they tested the LORD by saying, "Is the LORD among us or not?"
