1.1.2017	Romans 11:34-36	<p><sup>34</sup> For who has known the mind of the Lord, or who has been his counselor?" <sup>35</sup> "Or who has given a gift to him that he might be repaid?" <sup>36</sup> For from him and through him and to him are all things. To him be glory forever. Amen</p>
1.8.2017	John 10:14-15	<p><sup>14</sup> I am the good shepherd. I know my own and my own know me, <sup>15</sup> just as the Father knows me and I know the Father; and I lay down my life for the sheep.</p>
1.15.2017	Psalm 23:1-2	<p><sup>1</sup> The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want. <sup>2</sup> He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters.</p>
1.22.2017	Psalm 23:4	<p><sup>4</sup> Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me.</p>
1.29.2017	Psalm 23:3	<p><sup>3</sup> He restores my soul. He leads me in paths of righteousness for his name's sake.</p>
2.5.2017	Psalm 23:4	<p><sup>4</sup> Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me.</p>
2.12.2017	Psalm 23:5	<p><sup>5</sup> You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; you anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows.</p>
2.19.2017	Psalm 23:6	<p><sup>6</sup> Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life, and I shall dwell in the house of the LORD forever.</p>
2.26.2017	Proverbs 6:16-19	<p><sup>16</sup> There are six things that the LORD hates, seven that are an abomination to him: <sup>17</sup> haughty eyes, a lying tongue, and hands that shed innocent blood, <sup>18</sup> a heart that devises wicked plans, feet that make haste to run to evil, <sup>19</sup> a false witness who breathes out lies, and one who sows discord among brothers.</p>
3.5.2017	James 4:2-3	<p><sup>2</sup> You desire and do not have, so you murder. You covet and cannot obtain, so you fight and quarrel. You do not have because you do not ask. <sup>3</sup> You ask and do not receive, because you ask wrongly, to spend on your passions.</p>
3.12.2017	Galatians 6:9-10	<p><sup>9</sup> And let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up. <sup>10</sup> So then, as we have opportunity, let us do good to everyone, and especially to those who are of the household of faith.</p>
3.19.2017	Psalm 119:36	<p><sup>36</sup> Incline my heart to your testimonies, and not to selfish gain!</p>
3.26.2017	Romans 6:12-13	<p><sup>12</sup> Let no sin therefore reign in your mortal body, to make you obey its passions. <sup>13</sup> Do not present your members to sin as instruments for unrighteousness, but present yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to life, and your members to God as instruments for righteousness.</p>
4.2.2017	Psalms 115:11	<p><sup>11</sup> You who fear the LORD, trust in the LORD! He is their help and their shield.</p>

Date	Verse	Meditation Passage
4.9.2017	Philippians 3:17-19	<p><sup>17</sup> Brothers, join in imitating me, and keep your eyes on those who walk according to the example you have in us. <sup>18</sup> For many, of whom I have often told you and now tell you even with tears, walk as enemies of the cross of Christ. <sup>19</sup> Their end is destruction, their god is their belly, and they glory in their shame, with minds set on earthly things.</p>
4.16.2017	1 Corinthians 15:13-14	<p><sup>13</sup> But if there is no resurrection of the dead, then not even Christ has been raised. <sup>14</sup> And if Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is in vain and your faith is in vain.</p>
4.23.2017	Galatians 4:4-7	<p><sup>4</sup> But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth his Son, born of woman, born under the law, <sup>5</sup> to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons. <sup>6</sup> And because you are sons, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!" <sup>7</sup> So you are no longer a slave, but a son, and if a son, then an heir through God.</p>
4.30.2017	Genesis 14:19-20	<p><sup>19</sup> And he (Melchizedek, king of Salem) blessed him and said, "Blessed be Abram by God Most High, Possessor of heaven and earth; <sup>20</sup> and blessed be God Most High, who has delivered your enemies into your hand!" And Abram gave him a tenth of everything.</p>
5.7.2017	Luke 12:15	<p>And he (Jesus) said to them, "Take care, and be on your guard against all covetousness, for one's life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions."</p>
5.14.2017	2 Corinthians 9:7-8	<p><sup>7</sup> Each one must give as he has decided in his heart, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. <sup>8</sup> And God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that having all sufficiency in all things at all times, you may abound in every good work.</p>
5.21.2017	Jeremiah 9:23-24	<p><sup>23</sup> Thus says the LORD: "Let not the wise man boast in his wisdom, let not the mighty man boast in his might, let not the rich man boast in his riches, <sup>24</sup> but let him who boasts boast in this, that he understands and knows me, that I am LORD who practices steadfast love, justice, and righteousness in the earth. For in these things I delight, declares the LORD.</p>
5.28.2017	Ruth 2:20b	<p><sup>20b</sup> "The man is a close relative of ours, one of our redeemers."</p>
6.4.2017	Ruth 4:14	<p><sup>14</sup> Then the women said to Naomi, "Blessed be the LORD, who has not left you this day without a redeemer, and may his name be renowned in Israel!"</p>
6.11.2017	Ruth 4:17	<p><sup>17</sup> And the women of the neighborhood gave him a name, saying, "A son has been born to Naomi." They named him Obed. He was the father of Jesse, the father of David.</p>
6.18.2017	2 Corinthians 5:7	<p><sup>7</sup> For we walk by faith, not by sight.</p>
6.25.2017	Hebrews 11:8	<p><sup>8</sup> By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out to a place that he was to receive as an inheritance. And he went out, not knowing where he was going.</p>

Date	Verse	Meditation Passage
7.2.2017	Genesis 18:25	25 (Abraham talking with God) Far be it from you to do such a thing, to put the righteous to death with the wicked, so that the righteous fare as the wicked! Far be that from you! Shall not the Judge of all the earth do what is just?"
7.9.2017	Genesis 22:14	14 So Abraham called the name of that place, "The LORD will provide"; as it is said to this day, "On the mount of the LORD it shall be provided."
7.16.2017	Genesis 32:30	30 So Jacob called the name of the place Peniel, saying, "For I have seen God face to face, and yet my life has been delivered."
7.23.2017	Genesis 50:20	20 As for you, you meant evil against me, but God meant it for good, to bring it about that many people should be kept alive, as they are today.
7.30.2017	Exodus 3:14	14 God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM." And he said, "Say this to the people of Israel: 'I AM has sent me to you.'"
8.6.2017	Exodus 7:4	4 "The Egyptians shall know that I am the LORD, when I stretch out my hand against Egypt and bring out the people of Israel from among them."
8.13.2017	Exodus 9:16	16 But for this purpose I have raised you up, to show you my power, so that my name may be proclaimed in all the earth.
8.20.2017	Exodus 33:18-19	18 Moses said, "Please show me your glory." 19 And he said, "I will make all my goodness pass before you and will proclaim before you my name 'The LORD.' And I will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will show mercy on whom I will show mercy."
8.27.2017	Joshua 1:9	9 "Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be frightened, and do not be dismayed, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go."
9.3.2017	Joshua 24:15	15 "And if it is evil in your eyes to serve the LORD, choose this day whom you will serve, whether the gods your fathers served in the region beyond the River, or the gods of the Amorites in whose land you dwell. But as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD."
9.17.2017	Romans 1:5	5 Through whom we have received grace and apostleship to bring about the obedience of faith for the sake of his name among all the nations.
9.24.2017	Romans 1:16-17	16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek. 17 For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith for faith, as it is written, "The righteous shall live by faith."
10.1.2017	Romans 1:14-15	14 I am under obligation both to Greeks and to barbarians, both to the wise and to the foolish. 15 So I am eager to preach the gospel to you also who are in Rome.
10.8.2017	Romans 1:21-22	21 For although they knew God, they did not honor him as God or give thanks to him, but they became futile in their thinking, and their foolish hearts were darkened. 22 Claiming to be wise, they became fools.
